Verification of 100 Teaching Hours - Certification Candidate Pre-requisite Form

Pre-requisite: Complete a minimum of 100 Hours with a CanTRA Therapeutic Riding Program

Guidelines: Examples of what to include are: Leading; Sidewalking; Mounting; Dismounting; Assisting the Instructor with teaching, games, lesson plans; Basic knowledge of aids, lesson topics and disabilities; Volunteer training; Tacking up; Grooming; Horse preparation; Setting up the arena for a lesson; Fitting helmets; Practicing safety in the arena and stable; Organizing riders, volunteers, horses, etc.; Basic understanding and interaction with people with disabilities. These examples are a guideline and additional topics may be considered.

Verification: Please complete this form noting the number of hours for each topic practiced. This form must be signed by someone with “supervisory knowledge” of these completed hours. This form is to be submitted to the CanTRA office as part of the pre-requisites for certification. No credit will be issued for teaching hours unless this form is received.
